

Check out MVP's online RX resources at **mvphealthcare.com** and click *Manage Prescriptions*.

- Find your medications on the *MVP Formulary*¹ and note the copay Tier in which they are listed. The Formulary also shows whether your medication is subject to Prior Authorization² or Step Therapy³, has Quantity Limits, is available from the mail order pharmacy (if your benefit allows) or must be obtained at a specific pharmacy.
- Or if you are currently taking a specialty medication, you may be required to purchase it through Accredo. Accredo is a pharmacy that specializes in the dispensing of some high cost injectable and oral medications.
- Click on *Prescription Drug Forms* to find the *New Member Prescription Transition Form*. If you are taking a medication listed on the form, complete the form and send it to MVP. You can get a one-time, 30-day supply of medication while you talk with your doctor about switching to a covered drug or requesting an exception.
- Click Find a Pharmacy to see a list of pharmacies in your area that accept MVP insurance.
- Click *Mail Order Pharmacy* to learn about the benefits of mail order and how to get started. Getting the same prescription from the mail order pharmacy will usually cost less than at a retail pharmacy under your plan.
- -Maintenance medications will be conveniently delivered right to you in up to a 90-day supply, which saves you trips to the pharmacy. And standard shipping is free!
- -You can even order your medication refills online. You can also order refills by calling the phone number listed on the back of your ID card. Make sure to have your prescription number and credit card information available.
- -Click *Mail Order Pharmacy* and register to access personalized online pharmacy services including *My Rx Choices®*, the Express Scripts prescription drug comparison and savings program.

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IF YOUR DOCTOR PRESCRIBES A NEW MEDICATION

- Make sure that you understand what the new drug will treat, its possible side effects and what to do if you experience one.
- Talk to your doctor about whether a generic drug is available and right for you. If you must take a brand drug when a generic version is available, you may be responsible for a higher copayment or the brand drug may not be covered. Click *Tiers and Copays* on the *Manage Prescriptions* page of the MVP website for more details.

READ YOUR MAIL FROM MVP!

You will receive a copy of your prescription drug benefits and a certificate of coverage or plan summary in the mail. Read these important plan documents and keep them handy; they will tell you about:

- What is covered
- What your member contribution will be
- Any deductibles that apply to your plan
- The MVP Formulary (list of covered drugs)
- MVP's pharmacy programs (Step Therapy, Prior Authorization, Quantity Limits)
- Whether you need to use a specific pharmacy for specialty medications

USE YOUR MVP COVERAGE AT THE PHARMACY

- First, make sure that MVP covers your medications. You'll find information in this brochure about how to check your coverage and what to do if your medications are not covered.
- Show your MVP identification card to your pharmacist so that the information can be entered into the pharmacy's computer system.
- Pay your copayment and/or deductible*, which your pharmacist will know after processing the prescription with your MVP identification information.
- *You will receive plan documents from MVP that include this information for both retail pharmacies and your mail-order pharmacy. If you need a prescription before you receive them and you have questions, please call MVP's Customer Care Center at the phone number shown on your MVP identification card.
